

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR ALP (GDCE) CBT ON 22.07.2023.

- I. Minimum percentage of marks for qualifying for various communities is: UR-40%, OBC (Non creamy layer) -30%, SC-30%, ST-25%.
- II. There will be negative marking and 1/3 mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer.
- III. THERE WILL BE NO SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
- IV. A link for Viewing of Question Paper, Responses and Keys & Raising of Objections , if any, will be provided after CBT on RRC website.
- V. Those Securing MINIMUM MARKS (as specified in I above) WILL BE CALLED FOR Computer Based Aptitude Test (CBAT)
- VI. Qualifying marks for CBAT: A candidate needs to secure a minimum score of 42 marks in each of the test batteries to qualify CBAT. This is applicable to all community candidates and no relaxation is permissible.
- VII. Candidates will have to qualify in each of the test battery of CBAT to qualify for the post of ALP. The CBAT shall have questions and answer options only in English and Hindi. There shall be no negative marking in CBAT.
- VIII. The ALP merit list will be drawn only from amongst the candidates qualifying CBAT, with 70% weightage for the marks obtained in the CBT and 30% weightage for the marks obtained in CBAT.
- IX. Candidates are advised to visit website of RDSO (www.rdsso.indianrailways.gov.in -> Directorates -> Psycho Technical Directorate -> Candidates Corner) to acquaint themselves with the question patterns and other details of CBAT.
- X. Candidates equal to the number of vacancies will be called for Document verification.
- XI. In case of two or more candidates securing same marks, their merit position shall be determined by age criteria i.e., older person shall be placed at higher merit and in case age being same, then alphabetical order (a to z) of the name shall be taken into account to break the tie.
- XII. Appointment of selected candidates is subject to their passing requisite Medical Fitness Test (Fit in A-1 Medical Fitness Category) to be conducted by the Railway Administration, final empanelment shall depend on successful verification of other relevant documents of the candidate.
- XIII. Admission to every stage of recruitment process shall be purely provisional and subject to the candidate satisfying the prescribed eligibility/qualifying conditions.
- XIV. Mere issue of e-Call letter for the written examination (CBT) or the Aptitude test (CBAT) to the candidates will NOT imply that their candidature has been finally accepted by the RRC.
